Captain, Part-time

The Captain operates the U.S. Coast Guard inspected vessels across the Savannah River and/or near coastal waterways and sounds. Provide safe operation and navigation and enforces safety guidelines and rules. Interpret radar and weather instruments and operates vessel in varying weather conditions. Inspect vessel to ensure that crew and passengers observe regulations pertaining to safety and efficient operation of vessel. Supervise the crew in the loading and unloading of passengers and respond to and resolve passenger complaints. Maintain vessel's log book.

QUALIFICATIONS To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Regularly required to stand, use hands to finger, handle, or feet; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; and talk or hear. Required frequent walking or sitting and must be capable of occasionally lifting and/or moving between-50 – 80 lbs. Requires close, distance and color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus. Regularly exposed to outside weather conditions, frequently exposed to moving mechanical parts and moderate noise level. Must be able to pass a drug test, DOT physical and a criminal background check.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts and fumes or airborne particles. The employee is frequently exposed to toxic or caustic chemicals. The employee is occasionally exposed to wet and/or humid conditions; high, precarious places; outside weather conditions; risk of electrical shock; and vibration. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

Requires a High School equivalency, a valid U.S. Coast Guard master license of inspected vessels of 100 gross tons or greater, valid Radar Observer certificate, valid Marine Radio Operator Permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission and at least 1-year previous supervisory/management experience. Must have 2-3 captain experience and experience on Z-Drive Vessels.
