



Title VI Complaint Form

Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act states: “No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.”

The Environmental Justice component of Title VI guarantees fair treatment for all people. Chatham Area Transit Authority (CAT) is required to identify and address, as appropriate, disproportionately high and adverse effects of its programs, policies, and activities on minority and low-income populations. CAT is also required to take reasonable steps to ensure that Limited English Proficiency (LEP) persons have meaningful access to the programs, services and information CAT provides.
